Application Requirements

The program is open to all full-time undergraduates.

Applicants should meet the following requirements:

- (1) Reasonable English level with good comprehension skills
- (2) Interest in different culture and history
- (3) Academic courses and career aspirations that will benefit from this program
- (4) Enthusiastic, sociable and well suited to group activities for the program.

Programme Arrangement

- (1) Duration: 18 July - 6 August 2011
Students are required to arrive on 17 July and departure on 7 August.
- (2) Maximum number of participants: 30
- (3) Accommodation: single en-suite room on campus
- (4) Programme contents and structure:
 - (a) Advanced Academic English
 - (b) Local History and Culture
 - (c) Business, Banking and Finance
 - (d) Field Trips and various social activities
